In the 1990's, St. Paul's United Methodist Church embarked on a building expansion and improvement project. Our building and facilities needed to grow to afford us the ability and opportunity to further realize our Purpose: to praise God, grow as disciples, share our faith and serve others.

The project started at a cost of over 2.5 million dollars. With bequests and giving from the St. Paul's family totaling over 1 million dollars, the construction loan commitment initiated in February 2001 was \$1,375,000. The monthly loan payment at that time was \$11,935 with an 8.75% interest rate and a 20 year amortization period.

Effective February 2005, the construction loan was converted to a permanent mortgage loan to be amortized over 20 years. The monthly mortgage payment commencing February 1, 2005 was \$9,637.03. Under the terms of the loan, the bank reserved the right to call and review the loan every five years.

In July 2010, the mortgage loan, which had a balance of \$1,081,382.79, was renewed. The new monthly payment, commencing August 1, 2010, was \$6,858.82 with an interest rate of 5.75%, an amortization period of 25 years and a maturity date of July 29, 2035.

In August 2013, the mortgage loan, which now had a balance of \$1,005,641.88, was renegotiated. The new monthly payment, commencing September 1, 2013, was \$5,913.15 with an interest rate of 4.25% payable for 21 years and 11 months keeping the maturity date at July 29, 2035.

As of August 31, 2018, the mortgage balance was \$852,475.49. Again, under the terms of the loan agreement, the loan was called and reviewed. Effective September 1, 2018 the new mortgage payment is \$6,116.99 per month with an annual interest rate of 4.75% and payable for 17 years, keeping the maturity date at July 29, 2035.

Thank you to everyone who has been giving to pay off our mortgage. Praise God for all of the ministries our expansion has allowed and created.
