



## **TRUSTEES UPDATE**

The Board of Trustees wanted to update the Congregation with regard to some of the repairs, maintenance and work being done at the church. Over the past few months the heating problems have begun to be addressed. New thermostats have been installed and two of the systems were not working. So the contractor was able to fix one of the systems with parts from the other and the other area is now being serviced with space heaters. As soon as a new motor is in the systems will be up and operating, the thermostats will be set and we will be back to normal.

Last month we had a big crew come out to clean the kitchen. Unfortunately no left over chocolate was found, but all equipment was cleaned and the floors were power washed so we have a refreshed kitchen.

Other projects which have been ongoing include:

- 1) The church passed the annual fire inspection after repair of some of the emergency fixtures.
- 2) We have a leaking pipe in the fire suppression system in the gym and are awaiting the arrival of the replacement part for repairs.
- 3) The front entry sign was repaired.
- 4) New bookshelves were purchased and installed in the library.
- 5) Bill and Jeff Propert fixed the floor waxing machine.
- 6) We continue to clean up the classroom area under the sanctuary in the aftermath of the August storm.
- 7) Gary Chadwick replaced the hot water heater at the Sally Ike Parsonage.
- 8) A handyman repaired the garage door at the Sally Ike Parsonage.

A lot of small things have to go on to keep our facilities in good condition. Many thanks to a lot of unnamed people who volunteer their time and funds to keep our church repaired. We try to do a third Saturday morning work day each month but it often gets bumped to the fourth Saturday and if you can spare a few hours come out and join us. We start at 8:00am and are usually done by noon.

During May we will be concentrating on repairs and beautification of the parsonages. If you can come out and help with those items which will include some painting, landscaping, and minor repairs we would love to improve the pastor's and youth pastor's homes.
