Giving Numbers and Envelopes

One of the positions on the Finance Committee is the Finance Secretaries. The Finance Secretary positions are currently being held by Janet Post and Terry Penrod. The primary responsibility of the Finance Secretary is to record your donations to the various funds of St. Paul's. They do that recording through the envelopes you use for your giving each week. At the end of the year we will provide an official record of your giving that is recognized by the IRS and can be used when you file your income taxes. Needless to say it is to your benefit that all money that you donate to the Church be captured in that report. The best way for that to happen is if you use a Giver's Number on the envelopes you submit. If you are currently receiving numbered envelopes, then you have a Giver's Number already. Please use the envelopes sent to you or record your Giver's Number on any new envelopes you use. If you don't receive monthly numbered envelopes and would like to receive them, please contact our Church Secretary, Melissa Jensen, 732-458 2080 and she will arrange for you to receive them. If you don't have a Giver's Number and don't want to receive numbered envelopes, please contact Melissa Jensen, Janet Post or Terry Penrod to request a Giver's Number. Please be sure to write that number on the envelope you use for your weekly donations. We cannot guarantee we will include all of your giving if you don't use your Giver's Number.

Or if you currently receive envelopes and would like to discontinue them, also let us know *It is easier for our Financial Secretaries to keep records with numbers and disburse our donation letters at tax season.
