Joy Phillips, a native of South Jersey, began serving with WGM in Kenya in 1985. She served in a number of capacities at Tenwek Hospital, including nursing, Director of Tenwek Community Health and Development and Acting

Executive Officer. Joy later worked with Samaritan's Purse in South Sudan for two years. There she oversaw a hospital outreach and facilitated the distribution of 250,000 Bibles in 6 different languages throughout the country, which is the size of Texas and only has 3 kilometers of paved road.

She then spearheaded WGM's efforts to facilitate community transformation in South Sudan. Community Health Empowerment, Biblical Storytelling and Farming God's Way were effective training tools used that brought God's Kingdom closer to communities. Joy also facilitated medical teams from Tenwek Hospital to serve. Literally thousands of people were given the gift of physical sight and spiritual sight through mobile cataract clinics. Unfortunately, continued insecurity has led WGM to pull back from active ministry in this country.

Several years ago Joy was appointed as WGM's Compassionate Ministries Coordinator. In this role she provides training, connects people and resources, recruits and encourages the implementation of holistic transformation.

She is currently preparing to base in the Middle East where she will lead a team committed to using holistic transformation to show Jesus' love. Transformation does not take place in a vacuum. Your prayers and financial giving are a vital part in transforming individuals, communities and nations. Joy thanks you for your partnership.
